

The Purpose of SAA

The mandate of the School Administrators Association shall be:

- [1] To improve professional practice by increasing member knowledge and understanding.
- [2] To monitor evolving issues of importance to administrators.
- [3] To liaise with other professional organisations [NSTU Professional Associations Co-ordination committee, the TWAR (Teachers With Administrative Responsibilities) Committee, the NSTU Curriculum Committee, AASA, CAP, and other organisations].
- [4] To advise the Provincial Executive on matters affecting NSTU Professional Associations.
- [5] To provide leadership and advocacy for members on issues pertaining to educational leadership.
- [6] To initiate projects that support and enhance school leaders (such as the Annual Fall Conference hosted by SAA Locals, CAP National Conference when held in Nova Scotia, Membership on NSELB Board and Program Committee, Annual CAP Student Leadership and School Awards, Annual recognition and celebration of Exemplary Leadership).
- [7] To advise and provide support to all organisations and committees on matters affecting administration and supervision in public schools in the province of Nova Scotia.
- [8] To recognize excellence in the field of School Administration.
- [9] To be an official voice of the SAA member administrators in the province of Nova Scotia.

Membership

- [1] **Regular Membership**
Regular Membership in the School Administrators Association is restricted to active and active reserve members of the Nova Scotia Teachers Union.
NSTU members with administrative responsibilities are strongly encouraged to become regular members of the School Administrators Association.
- [2] **Student Intern Membership**
Student intern Membership in the School Administrators Association is available to full-time university students enrolled in education programs.
- [3] **Subscriber Member Membership** is available to an institution or a person who is not a regular or student intern member. Examples of subscriber members include:
 - former members of the association who have retired; or
 - who have entered other fields of education; or
 - such other persons as the School Administrators Association Executive shall declare eligible.
